Level of ride: 3 ½

Level III: This level is not recommended for the inexperienced rider/ green horses or out of shape horses. The terrain will be challenging and the pace quicker than level I-II. The obstacles will not be suited for green horses. However the average rider and horse will have no problem with this level.

Level IV: This level will be more suited for the advanced rider and horse. The terrain will be moderate to difficult at times. The obstacles will be safe for the **calm** experienced horse and rider only. Your horse will have to be in good physical shape and should be shod.

Description: This ride will follow a few trails leaving from Lake Riverside Estates, including Ironwood, Gerry and Little Peak.

Directions: Enter the north side of Lake Riverside from Hwy 371. Drive north on Lake Riverside Drive, Turn Left on Forest Springs, Turn Left on South Tanforan Court.
